### REMARKS

On 6-11-19 at 2207 hours, I heard a radio transmission from Dispatch stating that a witness was following a possible DWI S/B on South Main St at Wesleyan Hills Rd, a red Ford Ranger, CT registration

Officer Van Almkyrk and I responded from Long Lane Rd.

The witness was still giving updates on the location as we turned onto South Main St. As we arrived in the area of 1904 South Main St, the witness, \_\_\_\_\_, stopped us and stated that the suspect had just pulled into a driveway, pointing to 1904 South Main St. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that the operator had been a white male and was the only person in the vehicle. He stated that he had been directly behind the red pick up truck as it swerved across the road numerous times and that it had crossed the yellow line into oncoming traffic several times, almost striking a vehicle head on. That was when he had called 911.

As we pulled into the driveway, the operator had just exited the vehicle and walked to the side of the residence there. He then undid his pants and began urinating on the side of the house. We ordered him to walk back to us.

He was holding the wall of the house as he urinated. He began to walk back towards us and was extremely

unsteady on his feet, almost falling over numerous times and catching himself on the side of the house and a deck there.

The vehicle was registered out of \_\_\_\_\_ in Cromwell and as he made it to the front of his vehicle, having to lean onto it to support himself and keep from falling over, we asked whose house this was. He stated that it was his.

There was an extremely strong odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from the suspect and his eyes were extremely watery. His speech was also slurred and slow. I asked him if he had his license on him and if the truck was his. He stated that the truck was his and was unable to remove his own wallet from his pocket to retrieve his license.

Officer Skarzynski arrived on the scene at this point. The operator stated that his name was William Zingle. I asked if he had been drinking and he stated that he "had a few".

As I believed Zingle to be impaired, I requested that he perform SFST's. He stated to us that he had been arrested for DWI multiple times in the past and had went to jail for six months for it. He stated that we could not test him without his consent and that the keys were no currently in the ignition of the vehicle so we could not arrest him.

As \_\_\_\_\_ witnessed him driving, he had exited the vehicle as we pulled into the driveway to urinate on the house, and due to my training and experience, there was enough probable cause to place Zingle under arrest for DUI. I was unable to confirm the previous arrests for DUI or the alleged jail time with a records check at this time.


After the arrest, I entered his vehicle to collect his keys, which he had thrown to the center floor console as he exited the vehicle. In the cup holder was a cold beer, open, with over three quarters of it gone. On the passenger seat and thrown to the rear of the drivers seat, were five (5) empty beer cans, all cold with condensation on the outside. There was also warm Chinese food that it appeared that he had just picked up.

Zingle was transported to HQ for processing. At HQ, he was read his Miranda rights and the Implied Consent Advisory by Officer Skarzynski. He was afforded the opportunity to contact an attorney and declined at 2244 hours. I offered him the opportunity to conduct the SFST's again and he declined. After being read the Implied Consent Advisory, he refused to take the selected breath test.

He was processed on the charge of DUI. Due to him having no one to pick him up and because he was intoxicated, Sgt. Strick ordered him shipped to the hospital via Hunter's Ambulance for detox. He was released to the ambulance on a \$1,000.00 non-surety bond with a court date of 6-26-19 in GA 9.

We were able to wake the resident of the home. It was Zingle's brother and he stated that Zingle is going through a divorce and is currently staying there with him. Therefore, the vehicle was left parked in the driveway.



### REMARKS

On June 18, 2019 at approximately 1958 hours officers were dispatched to 311 East Main Street, Walgreens, for the report of the bomb threat.

Upon arrival officers made contact with employees from Walgreens and learned that a white male, wearing a hat, blue jacket with red stripes and blue shorts, made a comment that he had left a bomb in the store.

The employee in which the comment was made to reported it to their boss, who then contacted this agency.

Through the investigation officers learned that the suspect that made the comment, about leaving a bomb in the store was a regular customer named, Joseph Scianna. The comment that was made to the employee by Joseph was whispered and included him saying "tic, tic, tic" and mumbling "bomb". Before leaving Joseph stated "I put a bomb in the store".

Joseph was located at his residence, 57 Margartie Road, Middletown, CT, wearing the same outfit as described by the party he made the comment to. Joseph told officers that he was "joking" and the he even "whispered" the comment to the worker.

Joseph was subsequently arrested and transported to MPD HQ where he was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-181 Breach of Peace in the Second Degree as well as 53a-61aa Threatening in the First Degree. Joseph was fingerprinted, photographed and his demographics were updated. Joseph was released on a \$2,000.00 non-surety bond and is scheduled to appear at GA-09 in Middletown on June 26, 2019 at 0900 hours to face said charges.

It should be noted that the length of this incident was one hour and six minutes. During the incident several roads needed to be closed as well as Walgreens to ensure there was no sincere threat. The incident caused ten (10) MPD officers to be dedicated to investigating as well as resources from South District Fire and Middlesex Area Transit as they were needed to house the workers from Walgreens due to the poor weather.
