## REMARKS

On 06/16/19 at 1257 hours, while walking north on Main Street, I heard a disturbance at La Boca Restaurant. which had a special event consisting of dozens of people outside and hundreds inside. After several minutes allowing the people to try and work it out on their own, it became evident to me that no progress was being made by them and that all four parties involved were highly intoxicated.

While trying to separate them and move them away from the area, another female, who was later identified as Laura Rojas exited the restaurant and began yelling at the four women, stating that she was going to

"kick their asses". She approached them in an aggressive manner and began pushing them. I separated Rojas and instructed her to go back inside and not come back out. As she did this, she pushed me and stated "you can't tell me what to do, I am going to kick their asses". I told her not to touch me again at which point Rojas proceeded to the door but remained outside.

A short time later while my back was turned, Rojas returned and pushed my back hard enough to briefly knock me off balance and cause me to roll my left ankle which resulted in pain. I quickly turned and brought Rojas to the ground and placed her in handcuffs which were checked for tightness and double locked. Rojas was then brought to her feet by Officer Nettis and I, and escorted to the back of a patrol vehicle that arrived after officer assistance was requested over the police radio.

Officer Scoppetto transported Rojas to police headquarters with her screaming and kicking the entire time., It took several officers to calm and control Rojas once at the station.

As a result of this incident, Rojas was charged with the violation of C.G.S. 53a-167c; Assault of Police Officer, 53a-167c; Interfering with an Officer, and 53a-181; Breach of Peace 2nd Degree. She was held in lieu of a \$50,000 bond and assigned a G.A.-9 court date of 06/17/19 at 0900 hours. A supplemental report will be done once Rojas is calm enough to process at which point the UAR number will be documented.

REMARKS

On 6/14/19 I, Officer St. Peter, requested West Haven Police go to Justin Ortiz's place of employment (City Line Distributors) to take him in custody on a domestic warrant.

West Haven Police advised me that they located Ortiz and had taken him into custody. Officer Stroud and I responded to West Haven Police Department to take custody of Ortiz.

Officer Stroud and I secured Ortiz in handcuffs, placed him in the backseat of our police vehicle and transported him to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing. He was positively identified by his CT Identification card. While en-route I verbally advised Ortiz of his rights. Later at Headquarters he provided a sworn written statement regarding this incident.

Ortiz was charged with 53a-181d Stalking in the 2nd degree, 53a-183 Harassment in the 2nd degree, 53a-107 Criminal trespass in the 1st degree, 53a-115 Criminal mischief in the 1st degree and 53a-181 Breach of peace in the 2nd degree on UAR # 8876881. He was issued a next available court date of 6/17/19 at GA09 in Middletown and released to George Igartua of 24/7 Bail Bonds on a court set \$25,000 surety bond. Prior to his release Ortiz was issued conditions of release (all boxes checked including no contact with Victim1) which he stated he understood and signed.



On June 16th 2019, Middletown Officers responded to Vero Restaurant of 749 Saybrook Road, Middletown for the report of a past larceny.

The complainant and other eye witnesses on scene reported observing a white male in the parking lot looking through vehicles. The complainant had been moving his band equipment from the restaurant to his car and upon one of his trips to his car he interacted with the male who was described as being on drugs or intoxicated and commenting to the complainant that "you should lock you vehicle". This raised the complainant's suspicion who took note that the white male left in a blue colored Jeep Liberty with a large German Shepherd inside. The complainant later discovered that a green duffel bag containing microphones and various other musical instruments was missing valued at \$340.

While Officers were taking the initial report a blue colored Jeep Liberty with a large dog inside down northbound on Saybrook Road. The complainant and other witnesses on scene reported that was the suspect's vehicle. A motor vehicle stop was conducted of said vehicle where the sole operator was identified as Tyler Sulivan The vehicle Sullivan was driving was found to have a misuse marker plate, no insurance, and Sullivan's license was suspended.

Upon interacting with Sullivan he showed signs of intoxication and possible drug use as his pupils were dilated and speech slurred and staggered. The German shepherd in the vehicle was aggressive and Sullivan's windows were down. Sullivan was asked to roll up his windows and exit the vehicle. While questioning Sullivan about the incident he initially neither confirmed or denied involvement. While looking into the vehicle's windows from the outside a green colored duffel bag was observed in the back seat. Sullivan voluntarily retrieved the bag and upon opening it microphones and other musical instruments were found. Sullivan was placed in handcuffs and advised of his rights to which he understood and waived. He was placed in a police cruiser and remained on scene while Officers awaited an Animal Control Officer to assist with the removal of the dog. While waiting Sullivan was questioned and told an Officer "I broke into all those fucking cars and stole that shit".

The green bag was transported to the original complainant who positively identified the property as his, and provided a sworn written statement with his intent to pursue charges.

Upon removing the dog from the vehicle, and with Sullivan still on scene a search was conducted of the blue Jeep Liberty. Within the car numerous credit card(s) and identification(s) in various names, multiple call phones, a lap top, multiple back packs, flashlight(s), and a leatherman tool were found and taken as evidence. The vehicle was towed off rotation.

This investigation is ongoing and addition charges are forthcoming, many of the item(s) found within the vehicle have been linked to other larcenies and burglaries occurring within Middlesex County.

Sullivan was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters and processed under the above listed charges, he was held on a \$50,000 bond, and given a court date of June 17th 2019 at 0900 hours.
