REMARKS

On 6/11/2019, at approximately 2225 hours, Officer Wasilewski and I were assigned to a walking beat on the north end of Main Street. We observed a male walking northbound on the east sidewalk of the street in the area of 534 Main Street. I was able to identify the male as Larry Floyd Jr. from prior law enforcement interactions. Floyd had a portable speaker in his hand and was playing music that was clearly audible to us from approximately 100 yards away.

Floyd stopped in front of TL Unisex Salon, which was open for business at the time. It should be noted that there are occupied residential apartments above the business. I observed a customer attempting to enter the salon to solicit the business. Floyd stood in between the individual and the door, preventing them from entering. I could hear Floyd yelling, but

could not make out what he was saying. It was not clear to me at this time if Floyd knew this person, or if he was harassing them. After several seconds the person walked around Floyd and entered the salon. We observed Floyd standing in front of the doorway screaming and yelling. We were unable to make out what he was saying, but it was evident that he was yelling in an aggressive tone. I observed lights turning on in the apartments above, and the residents were looking out the window to see what was happening. We began to make our way to address Floyd's behavior and we observed him confront another customer, again preventing them from entering the business and yelling in an aggressive manner.

When we crossed the street we could both clearly see that Floyd was holding a 25 ounce can of "Natty Daddy" malt liquor beverage in his hand, which he attempted to cover with a brown paper bag. The can was open and it was evident that Floyd had been consuming the contents, in violation of the Middletown City ordinance against publicly consuming alcohol. Officer Wasilewski began to speak with Floyd and he was slurring his speech and unsteady on his feet. While he spoke the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanated from his breath. It was clear to us that Floyd was intoxicated. At this point Officer Freiman arrived as back up. I entered into the salon and spoke with the employees and customers. I asked if Floyd was creating a disturbance, and they all indicated he had. They requested that he be removed from the area.

Floyd provided his identification and I informed him he would be receiving an infraction for creating a public disturbance. I also informed him that he would be receiving a verbal warning for drinking alcohol in public. As I was completing the infraction Floyd began yelling obscenities towards me. I warned him that any further disturbances to the residents above would result in his arrest.

I provided Floyd with his infraction and he began to walk away. As he did he began screaming obscenities towards us. Floyd was heading towards his apartment and we ignored his behavior in the hope he would go home and go to bed. Floyd crossed the street and reached the area of the soup kitchen. There was construction in the area and Floyd was walking under flood lights and he was clearly illuminated. As he did he was still yelling obscenities. We saw him encounter another male (later identified as _____). Floyd stopped and we could see him yelling at _____. Floyd then took a fighting stance by blading his body, dropping his knees, balling his fists and lifting them to his face. We immediately began to run to the area. I called Detective Lathrop, who was working at the construction site to advise him of the impending fight. As we got closer I observed _____ turn away and Floyd kicked him in the back. An unidentified woman was walking south on the sidewalk with her dog past Floyd and _____. The dog was startled by Floyd's behavior and began barking. Floyd then squared off with the dog and began to lunge at it and then back up.

At this point we were able to engage Floyd and ordered him to the ground. He first complied and raised his hands. He then began to lie on the ground, but when we attempted to put his hands behind his back, he began violently pulling away from us, placing his hands under his body. I pried his right arm from under his body by utilizing my baton for leverage and took control of his right arm and hand. After several seconds of Floyd attempting to escape from our grasp and pull away from us, we were able to place him in custody. During the struggle Floyd sustained an abrasion to his forehead. Floyd then began making threats to the officer's families, indicating that he would kill our children.

_____ was not willing to give a written statement, but indicated that Floyd began yelling at him for no reason. Floyd told him to "suck his dick" and assumed a fighting stance. _____ attempted to walk away and Floyd kicked him in the back, causing pain and discomfort.

I requested EMS personnel to assess Floyd. Floyd complained of dizziness and was transported to the Middlesex Hospital ED.

Floyd was issued infraction S520870-2 for violation of CGS 53a-181a creating a public disturbance and was given an answer date of 7/2/2019.

Floyd was given a WPTA and was issued MSC MC716062 for violation of CGS 53a-61 assault 3rd, 53a-181 breach of peace, and 53a-167a interfering with a police officer. He is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 6/24/2019 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 6-12-19 at 0837 hours, I observed Anthony Gaetano, whom I know from numerous previous encounters, operating CT registration , a white Ford Windstar Van, S/B on High St at Spring St with no front license plate.

A records check showed that the plate had expired on 4-10-19 and belonged on another vehicle that was registered to the Middlesex YMCA.

I was able to stop the vehicle on Newfield St at Westfield St. Gaetano stated that he had just purchased the vehicle and the plate had been on it at the time. He stated that the vehicle was not registered or insured.

He was released on the scene on an MSC for Misuse of Plate, Operating a Motor vehicle Without Insurance, Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, and No Front Plate with a court date of 6-26-19 in GA 9.

The vehicle was parked on private property to be recovered at a later date and the plate was seized to returned to the DMV.

REMARKS

On 5/16/2019, at approximately 2302 hours, I responded to Price Chopper as back up and as a supervisor for a reported shoplifting. Dispatch advised the suspect left in a red Buick Lesabre bearing CT registration . While in route, Officer Remotti advised he had located the suspect vehicle behind the residence of the registered owner. Myself, Officers Remotti and Mudano approached 150 Washington Street apartment 1, the registered owners apartment. I know this apartment has been the subject of recent complaints about drug dealing and drug use. When we knocked on the door and a male (later identified as) walked out. I asked if he owned the vehicle and he said no, and that the owner was in the apartment.

I went in the apartment and spoke with . The apartment was also occupied by Matthew Springman and an unidentified female. . enied being at Price Chopper, and indicated that : had borrowed the vehicle. While speaking with : Springman repeatedly was reaching into his right pant pocket. Fearing that he could be reaching for a weapon to utilize against me, I told him to keep his out of his pockets. After my second warning, Springman again began to reach towards his right pocket. I patted him down for weapons and in his right pant pocket I felt what I was immediately able to identify as a bundle of suspected heroin. I removed the bundle and I found 13 wax paper bags, each containing a white powder like substance I believed to be heroin. I asked Springman if it was heroin or Fentanyl (a cheaper much stronger and deadly narcotic often substituted for heroin). Springman stated he did not know. I tested the powder utilizing NARK 33 and it tested positive for the presumptive presence of Fentanyl. Each bag of Fentanyl typically contains .1 gram of the drug. Weighing the drug would be near impossible because of the small amount and would also expose officers

to danger.

Springman was given a WPTA and issued MSC MC541264 for violation 21a-279(a)(1) possession of narcotics. He is scheduled to appear at GA9 at 0900 hours.

On 6-14-19 I, Officer Small was assigned to the Patrol Division on the Overnight Shift.
I observed CT Reg [redacted] traveling West on Washington St at High St. That same vehicle had an

inoperable driver's side tail light and was subsequently stopped.

DMV files showed that registration to be expired as of 2-9-19, and the insurance coverage was unconfirmed. The vehicle was being operated by the owner, whom I recognized as Peter Schwink. Schwink stated that he did not have any paperwork for the vehicle. A check of Schwink's license showed it to be suspended as of 5-31-19. Schwink stated that the vehicle did not have any insurance coverage.

The vehicle was towed by D&M Towing by rotation. Schwink was issued Misdemeanor Summons # MC540583 for Inoperable Taillight (14-96e), Operating under Suspension (14-215), Operating an Unregistered M/V (14-12(a)*), and Operating with Insufficient Insurance Coverage (14-213b). Schwink was informed that he must appear at GA 9 in Middletown on 6-20-19 at 0900 hours. Schwink acknowledged, signed the summons, and was released on a PTA.

It should be noted that Schwink was issued a Summons on 4-20-19 for 14-12(a)* and 14-213b.

REMARKS

On 6-14-19 I, Officer Small was assigned to the Patrol Division on the Overnight Shift.

At approximately 0529 hours I was in a parking lot of a known business in the City of Middletown. While there, I heard Victim #1 yelling. Upon speaking with her, she informed me that her ex-boyfriend, Anthony Crawley had borrowed her vehicle and failed to return it.

Upon investigating the matter, it was learned that Crawley and Victim #1 have a valid Protection Order in place with Victim #1 listed as the Protected party and Crawley listed as the Defendant. The order is a full no contact order and to stay away from the home of the protected person.

On 6-13-19 Crawley went to Victim #1's residence and retrieved that vehicle. All morning on this date (6-14-19) Crawley and Victim #1 had been communicating.

I called and spoke with Crawley who confirmed that he had Victim #1's vehicle. Crawley was en route to our location. Upon Crawley's arrival, his identity was confirmed and the Protective Order was confirmed to be valid.

Crawley was taken into custody without incident and transported to this department. Crawley was advised he was being charged with Violation of a Protection Order (14-223), and read the Notice of Rights form. Bond was set at \$10,000 non-surety. Crawley was released and is scheduled to appear at GA 9 in Middletown. Conditions of Release Family Violence Form was completed with all boxes checked.

The vehicle was turned over to Victim #1 without incident.
