REMARKS

On 6/8/19 at approximately 2026 hours I, Officer St. Peter, responded to a location in Middletown for the report of a verbal domestic.

Upon arrival I spoke with Victim1. He stated his ex-girlfriend who he currently resides with became upset with him because he had her served with eviction paperwork. He stated she got into a verbal argument with him so he called police before the incident could escalate. He stated the argument was verbal in nature and never became physical. I then spoke with Jodi Gilbert-Ranney. She stated she became upset because Victim1 was evicting her. She stated the argument was only verbal in nature. No injuries were observed on either party and the residence was well kept and there were no signs of a disturbance.

Victim1 stated he would leave the residence for the night to avoid any further incident.

On 6/8/19 at approximately 2100 hours Officer Jeffries and I responded back to the area for the report of an intoxicated person creating a disturbance in the street. The description of the party in question provided by dispatch, matched Gilbert-Ranney's description.

As I arrived on scene I observed Victim1's truck driving southbound on Fowler Ave. I observed Gilbert-Ranney sitting in her white 2003 Toyota Camry bearing CT reg # [REDACTED] (which was parked on Fowler Ave facing southbound with the driver door open). After the truck past, I observed Gilbert-Ranney slam her door and take off at a high rate of speed toward the truck. I increased my speed in an attempt to catch up to her to initiate a traffic stop. She continued to increase her speed. The area where she was traveling at a high rate of speed was a residential street and there was a couple walking on the street, which appeared to be frightened as Gilbert-Ranney sped past them. Gilbert-Ranney then turned right onto Deerfield Ave following Victim1's truck. As she turned onto Deerfield Ave I could hear her tires screeching. I followed her onto Deerfield Ave. I observed Gilbert-Ranney driving on the wrong side of the road attempting to pass Victim1. She got up next to his vehicle and began to scream at him through her open window. I could not make out what she was saying but I could hear her yelling loudly at Victim1 while traveling in the oncoming travel lane. I activated my emergency lights and siren in an attempt to stop Gilbert-Ranney. She pulled her vehicle over in the area of 28 Deerfield Ave. I pulled past her and also stopped Victim1. Officer Jeffries pulled behind Gilbert-Ranney's vehicle.

I requested Gilbert-Ranney step out of her vehicle. Officer Jeffries and I placed her in handcuffs and placed her in the backseat of my police vehicle.

I spoke with Victim1. He stated he was driving past the residence on his way to a family members house after going to the store. He stated he had no intention of stopping at the residence and when he saw Gilbert-Ranney, he was just trying to get away from her. He advised me her driving recklessly and yelling at him caused him alarm. He further advised me that Gilbert-Ranney was screaming vulgar language at him as she yelled. Victim1 stated he feared that Gilbert-Ranney was going to crash into his vehicle. I offered victim's services to Victim1 but he refused. I advised him that Gilbert-Ranney was going to be placed under arrest. Victim1 left the area.

I then spoke with Gilbert-Ranney. I advised her that she was being placed under arrest and she would be transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing. An inquiry as to if her motor vehicle was insured showed the insurance was unconfirmed. Gilbert-Ranney admitted her insurance had lapsed on the vehicle.

Gilbert-Ranney was charged with 53a-181 Breach of peace, 14-213b Failure to have minimum insurance, 14-219a Driving to endanger, 14-222 Reckless driving and 14-236 Failure to maintain lane. She was issued a next available court date of 6/10/19 at GA09 in Middletown at 0900 hours. She was released on a \$10,000 non-surety bond. Conditions of release were explained to Gilbert-Ranney. She stated she understood and signed the form.

Nothing further.

REMARKS

On 6-7-19 at 0807 hours, I was dispatched to an address in Middletown for a domestic assault that had just occurred. Victim had called and stated that she and her husband, Xavier Hawkson, had argued over him using her vehicle and that he had punched her in the face and had walked away, N/B on Bartholomew Rd, wearing a green shirt and khaki shorts.

En route to the scene, Officer Hertler located Xavier on Saybrook Rd at Reservoir Rd. He stopped and spoke with him there. Officer Tetrault and I arrived on the scene moments later. Xavier stated that his wife, Victim, was supposed to pick him up from work at Fedex. He stated that it should have taken her 15 minutes to get there, but instead it took her over an hour. He stated that the two argued in the bedroom and that she intentionally and open handed slapped him across the right side of his face with her left hand. He stated that he then left to walk to his second job at Dollar General.

We all then responded back to 56 Summer Hill Rd. On the way, Xavier pointed out that Victim had just passed us in the opposite direction in her vehicle. We stopped her at Bartholomew Rd and Saybrook Rd and had her respond back to 56 Summer Hill Rd as well.


There, Victim stated that the two argued over Xavier using her vehicle. She stated that she had a doctors


appointment in up state New York and had to go so he couldn't use her vehicle. She stated that he had her phone, so she took his. She further stated that she observed his back pack on the floor and picked it up. She stated that Xavier then grabbed the back pack and began struggling with her to take it back and that he then punched her in the face and left on foot. This is when she called police.

Victim had red marks/scratches across her chest that she stated that Xavier had caused. However, she stated that he had been pulling on her shoulder and the back pack from behind. Also, Xavier has no finger nails, as he bites them short. As Officer Tetrault and I spoke with Victim, she continually drew her right hand across her chest, in the exact direction that these scratches were in, possibly self-inflicting them.

With the two opposite descriptions of the incident, mostly non-visible injuries, Victim having to go to New York for the day and Xavier having to work all day, knowing that some form of violent and tumultuous behavior had occurred in the apartment, both were issued Summons's for Disorderly Conduct with a court date of 6-10-19 in GA 9.

Both were also issued Conditions Of Release Family Violence, with the boxes, Do not assault, threaten, etc., not to possess a weapon, and not to use intoxicants or controlled substances checked, as both are from West Africa and have no family or friends that they can stay with. They both stated that they were not afraid to have each other in the residence and we explained the conditions of release to them at length, with both stating that they understood.


