REMARKS

On June 2 2019, I was dispatched to Price Chopper parking lot, 855 Washington St, on report of a two vehicle parking lot crash. Upon arrival, one vehicle was moved and the other was still in the parking stall. It should be noted that this parking lot is greater than ten parking spaces.

I spoke to _____ operator of CT reg AT35068, a gray Infiniti SUV. _____ has Kemper Independence Insurance, policy number VF663413, expired 11/06/2019. _____ stated that she finished grocery shopping and was walking out to her vehicle, when she was advised by and witness that her vehicle

was struck by another vehicle, which was still on scene. stated that her vehicle was parked in the east most row of the parking lot. stated she did not get the witnesses information and that they had left prior to police arrival. stated she was advised by the unknown witness that a vehicle was pulling into a parking space north of her vehicle and struck the passenger side door causing functional damage. stated she had to leave the scene. I provided the case number and advised her I would follow up with her.

I spoke to Walter Cihocki Jr, operator of CT commercial reg K93355, a misused registration plate, owned by Cihocki Jr. Cihocki Jr was operating a 2004 Ford E350 Super Duty, VIN FDSE35L94HA40109, which should have CT combination reg 24CC10, which is expired 11/12/2017, and has no valid insurance. The vehicle showed the registered owner to be Glastonbury Fireplace Gallery LLC, of Glastonbury. Cihocki Jr was identified via CT license number 132842139. Dispatch stated Cihocki Jr was showing no license, but a valid Identification Card, with the number provided, therefore Cihocki Jr was not valid to drive.

Cihocki Jr stated that he was driving eastbound on Washington St and entered the Home Depot Plaza in the west most entrance, near the car wash. Cihocki Jr stated that he hopped the center median at the entrance of the driveway and drove over a parking sign post causing his front driver side tire to go flat. Cihocki Jr stated that he continued to park his vehicle in the Home Depot parking lot and entered Home Depot to purchase nuts and bolts. Cihocki Jr stated he then entered his vehicle, knowing it had a flat front tire and drove it to the Price Chopper area of the parking lot. Cihocki Jr stated he attempted to park his vehicle in the east most row and struck an unoccupied parked vehicle. Cihocki Jr stated he backed out of the parking space and waited for police to arrive.

I observed Cihocki Jr's vehicle to have a completely flat front driver side tire, with a very large hole in it. The rubber portion of the tire was almost completely off of the metal rim. I observed Cihocki Jr, who did not make much sense and appeared to have some sort of unknown medical issue. Cihocki Jr fell asleep multiple times, while sitting in the drivers seat, in which his head would slump down in front of him, hit the steering wheel, causing his horn to beep and wake him up. I observed this occur approximately twelve separate times. I contacted dispatch to send an ambulance to the scene to evaluate Cihocki Jr's wellbeing. I did not smell any alcohol or see anything narcotics related in plain view.

Hunters arrived on scene. Cihocki Jr stated he does not drink alcohol or take illegal narcotics. Cihocki Jr stated that he takes all of his medication as advised. Hunters employees asked Cihocki Jr multiple standardized easy questions, in which Cihocki Jr did not know the answers to, including which day of the week and what year it was. Cihocki Jr then stated he wished to go to the hospital because he did not feel right. Cihocki Jr was transported to Middlesex Hospital.

I removed the misused CT commercial reg K93355, which was confiscated. I placed it in the DMV return bin and completed the proper paperwork.

Ofc Skarzynski remained on scene until Cihocki Jr's vehicle was towed by Alpha Auto. Ofc Skarzynski completed a tow form, which I later provided to Cihocki Jr.

I followed Cihocki Jr to Middlesex Hospital, where I issued Cihocki Jr Misdemeanor Summons, number MC540604, for violation of the following CGS:
14-147(c) Misuse of Plates
14-12a* Operation of Unregistered Motor Vehicle
14-36a Operation of MV without a License

Cihocki Jr was issued a court date of June 13 2019, at GA 9. I provided Cihocki Jr with a copy of the

summons, which he signed for. As Cihocki Jr was signing the summons at the hospital, he fell asleep as he was signing his last name and had to be woken up to finish signing.

I advised Cihocki Jr that I was based I was taking his physical license and submitting it to the DMV to ensure that he is retest and submits evidence of fitness to drive. I completed the Law Enforcement Authorization Form to take Possession of CT OP License.



REMARKS

On 06-06-2019 Detective Schreiner and I were traveling south on Hamlin Ct. We were behind the vehicle bearing AT44068 which stopped at the stop sign at the intersection of Hamlin Ct and William St. This is directly in front of the Idella W. Howell Child Development Center (day care). This vehicle is known to be operated by James Weston. Detectives Schreiner and I are familiar with Weston from a recent search and seizure warrant where the Street Crime Unit discovered a sizable amount of narcotics in Weston's vehicle, as well as where he was living at the time, as well as a firearm from where he was living (MPD case number 18-33166).

Detective Schreiner and I observed the vehicle cross the center yellow line on two occasion in violation of CGS 14-236. We also observed the vehicle's license plate was obstructed by a plastic cover in violation of CGS 14-18(c).

Detective Schreiner and I conducted a motor vehicle stop on High St just south of it's intersection with Church St. I approached the passenger side as Detective Schreiner approached the driver's side. When I reached the front passenger window I noticed Weston take a pack of Newport cigarettes from the passenger seat and tuck it between his legs. I thought this was odd as there would be no logical reason for someone to feel the need to do that when being pulled over by police in my experience.

As I stood at the window I noticed a baseball bat in the front passenger compartment between the passenger seat and the center console. There were items all over Weston's passenger seat including money, his wallet and other random items which I found unusual as there was a person seated there just moments prior. This led me to believe Weston was attempting to hide or retrieve something hastily in his vehicle as he was being pulled over.

I then asked Det Schreiner to have Weston step out of the vehicle due to his close proximity to the baseball bat which was easily within his reach and his most recent arrest where we located a firearm at his residence. Weston refused to come out of the vehicle. Weston refused to step out of the vehicle after being asked numerous times. Det Schreiner observe Weston reaching toward the center console of the vehicle at which point he forcibly removed him from the vehicle where Weston was handcuffed.

Det Schreiner then patted Weston down and located a heavy folding knife in his front pants pocket. A further search of Weston yielded negative results.

I was standing by the open driver's side door of the vehicle and observed small pieces of a green leafy substance I was able to identify as marijuana on both the floor and the center console area. I was able to identify this substance as marijuana from my training and experience as a narcotics detective. As I was retrieving the marijuana from the floor of the vehicle I noticed a small amount of a white flaky substance I was able to identify as cocaine. Det Schreiner retrieved a cocaine test kit (NARK #4) to test the suspected cocaine showing a positive result.

A further search of the vehicle revealed .4 grams of cocaine wrapped in a dollar bill. The dollar bill was stuffed into the pack of Newport cigarettes Weston had initially had between his legs. Det Schreiner located the cigarette pack on the front passenger seat.

A search of the vehicle revealed \$110 US currency in the driver's side door pocket as well as a THC distillate vaporizing pen. On Weston's front passenger seat Schreiner located an additional \$97 US

REMARKS

On 6-7-19 I, Officer Small was assigned to the Patrol Division on the Overnight Shift.

Just before 0049 hours, I observed CT Reg AS71377 traveling North on Main St at Hartford Ave. That vehicle only had one working rear brake light. That same vehicle was stopped.

The operator was identified by his Adult learners Permit as Angel Aponte. The passenger informed me that she did not have a valid license.
