### REMARKS

On June 13, 2019, at approximately 2047 hours, I was dispatched to 12 Walnut St. on a motor vehicle complaint.

The witness said she was a passenger in a vehicle and the operator had to do an evasive maneuver to avoid being hit by a vehicle, a gold pick up truck with a cap over the bed, pulling out of a driveway on Chestnut St. She identified the driver as a middle aged white male, facial hair, wearing a yellow T-shirt. She watched him drive the truck back into the driveway and they drove home. She was not positive what house he lived in, but pointed to Chestnut St. and said the truck would be in the driveway a few houses down on the left.

I observed a vehicle matching the description parked at 77 Chestnut St., a 2004 Chevrolet Silverado, bearing CT Combo      owned by a      We made contact with a male on the 2nd floor

who matched the description as the operator the witnesses provided me. The male appeared to be middle aged, had facial hair and was wearing a yellow shirt. He was later identified as Richard Maynard (45). When he answered the door he appeared to be highly intoxicated. He was slurring his words, could barely stand and had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. I was able to get him to tell me his first name, "Rich", but he was uncooperative and refused to tell me any other details. I advised him if he did not identify himself he would be placed under arrest.

At this time Maynard told Officers to "fuck off" and tried to slam the door in my face. I was standing in the doorway when the door smashed against my foot. I told him to he was under arrest and attempted to grab ahold of him but he was able to break free. I observed Maynard fleeing down a hallway and followed him. We ended up in a kitchen and Maynard was standing by a kitchen table in close proximity to two kitchen knives. Officer St. Peter and I each grabbed a wrist of Maynard as he immediately tried pulling away from us. I assisted Maynard to the ground where we were able to place him in handcuffs. Several times while searching him Maynard tensed up, pulled away and tried to turn at me as if he was attempting to spit at me. He was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

As a result of this incident Richard Maynard was charged with violating CGS 53a-167a, Interfering with an Officer and 29-12, Failure to Submit to Fingerprinting. He was held on a \$10,000 Surety Bond and schedule to appear at GA9 on June 14, 2019 at 0900 hours.

### REMARKS

On 5/30/19 at approximately 1653 hrs, I, Officer Tiano responded to the area of Dekoven Drive and Washington Street for a 2 car motor vehicle accident.

During this accident investigation, it was revealed through both operator's statements and evidence of vehicle damage the accused, Zuleyka Rodriguez, was traveling south bound on Dekoven Drive just north of the intersection of Dekoven Drive and Washington Street. At the time of this collision, the accused was operating a red 2014 Ford Focus bearing CT. Reg. The accused did not notice that the vehicle in front of her had come to a stop in traffic. The accused was unable to stop her vehicle in time before the front bumper of her vehicle collided into the rear bumper of the vehicle in front of her. At the time of this collision it was verified that the accused did not have active insurance coverage on her vehicle since 7/18/17 through her own admission and her last known insurance company.

At the conclusion of this investigation, the accused was issued a misdemeanor summons (#MC330340) for the violation of C.G.S. 14-218a Traveling Too Fast for Conditions and the offense of C.G.S. 14-213b Insufficient Insurance. The accused was issued a court date of 6/24/19 at Middletown Superior Court G.A. 9 at 0900 hrs and later released on a promise to appear.

Rodriguez's State Police Records Check ( ) lists no prior arrests/convictions.

## REMARKS

### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

On 06/23/2019, at approximately 12:36 hours, the Middletown Police Department responded to an undisclosed address on a report of a physical domestic complaint.

The victim who appeared to be nervous and later seen crying stated that on 06/23/19, at approximately 12:30 hours, while washing dishes in the kitchen her boyfriend Michael Joseph JOHNSON (AGE 50) came into the kitchen and started to give her orders. The victim stated that she continued to do the dishes and JOHNSON whacked her in the back of her head with his hand. The victim stated that she grabbed the closest phone she could find and she placed a call to 911. While the victim spoke on the phone to the 911 dispatcher, JOHNSON came behind the victim and told the victim to hang-up the call and grabbed the phone out of the victim's hand. On scene, JOHNSON was adamant that the victim lied to the police and that

the incident was entirely verbal only.

Although there were no obvious injuries to the victim. The victim did state that she did experienced pain and discomfort to the back of her head, however, the victim refused medical attention on scene.

JOHNSON'S mother was home at the time of the incident and she informed police that the victim had told her that the accused had struck the victim in the back of her head prior to police arrival.

The accused Michael Joseph JOHNSON (L. .... ) was taken into police custody and transported to headquarters without incident. At headquarters Johnson was advised of his Miranda Rights and processed on the charges of being in violation of C.G.S. SEC 53a-182, Disorderly Conduct and C.G.S. SEC. 53a-183b, interfering with an Emergency call.

JOHNSON was able to post \$10,000.00 bail and was released on his own recognizance. JOHNSON was advised not to return to the home and not to have any contact with the victim as part of his conditions of release. Court set for Monday, 06/24/2019, at 09:00 am located at (GA-09) 1 Court Street Middletown, CT 06457.

**REMARKS**

On Sunday, June 23, 2019 at approximately 2125 hours I, Officer Skarzynski and Officer Ward were dispatched a known address for the report of a domestic related incident, physical in nature. While en-route said address, Central Communications reported that a male party, identified as Terrill was hitting a female in the shower, Terrill was reported to be intoxicated. Sergeant Strick advised Central Communications that she was also en-route to the domestic incident.

Myself and Officer Ward arrived on scene. As we approached the residence I observed a female party, later identified as [redacted] running out of the attached garage towards us. [redacted] was wrapped in a bath towel, she was screaming "please come in the house" "he is upstairs and he's drunk". Said Officers entered the attached garage, I could immediately hear arguing coming from the first floor. As I left the basement and walked up the stairs to the first floor I observed a young Hispanic male, later identified as [redacted] in a verbal argument with a black male party, later identified as the suspect Terrill Hart.

was yelling at Terrill, "How can you do that to a woman" "You're not supposed to beat on a woman". said "Let's go outside and do this" "I'll smack you silly". I separated both parties and told [redacted] to go outside with [redacted]. Sergeant Strick arrived shortly thereafter and spoke to [redacted]. VICTIM-1 was in a bathrobe, with a pile of clothes in her hands. VICTIM-1 was sobbing, I could see a small open cut on her neck. VICTIM-1 was asked if she was injured and in need of medical attention, VICTIM-1 said she was not injured and refused medical attention.

I asked Terrill what had happened on this evening. Terrill said after work he decided to go out and have a couple of drinks. Terrill said he came home and was in the driveway, unable to get out of his vehicle because he was intoxicated and was going to throw up in the driveway. Terrill said he was asking VICTIM-1 to come outside, attach the garden hose so he could clean the vomit off of the driveway. Terrill said he was mad because victim-1 had difficulty attaching the hose. Terrill said he was also mad because [redacted] who has been renting at their residence has a vehicle that needed some mechanical work, and has been sitting in their driveway unfixed. Terrill said he got into a verbal argument with [redacted] in regards to her vehicle, [redacted] was supposed to take care of the mechanical work and hadn't completed the job as of yet.

Terrill said he went inside, victim-1 left the residence to drop off two of her friends. When VICTIM-1 returned, she went into the bathroom with their room mate [redacted]. Terrill said he heard "Something funny" in the bathroom and realized that VICTIM-1 was taking shower with [redacted]. Terrill said he was mad and barged into the bathroom. He said he was yelling at VICTIM-1 and [redacted]. Terrill said "I never put a hand on VICTIM-1". It should be noted that Terrill appeared to be intoxicated, he was slouching forward, smelled of an alcoholic beverage and was slurring his words.

VICTIM-1 gave this Officer a sworn written statement, first noting that she has been in an intimate relationship with Terrill for the past 16-years. On this night, VICTIM-1 said that Terrill had arrived home and was puking in the driveway. Terrill got mad because she couldn't hook up the hose like he asked. Terrill came into the house and began to yell at VICTIM-1. VICTIM-1 said she brought both of her friends home and came back to the residence. When VICTIM-1 went into the house and wanted to stay away from Terrill. [redacted] asked VICTIM-1 to take a shower with her, then they were going to lock themselves in [redacted] room and stay away from Terrill for the night. While they were in the shower, VICTIM-1 heard Terrill scream then barge into the bathroom. Terrill was screaming at VICTIM-1, [redacted] ran out of the bathroom. VICTIM-1 said she tried to get away, stating she was aware of the fresh wound on her neck but was not sure how it got there. VICTIM-1 said she was able to get out of the bathroom and into the living room. MVICTIM-1 said Terrill was trying to get [redacted] and [redacted] to leave, but they refused due to their concern over VICTIM-1's safety. VICTIM-1 said the police arrived shortly thereafter.

I took sworn written statements from [redacted] and [redacted]. Both of their statements mirrored VICTIM-1's version of the events on this evening. [redacted] told this Officer that when he heard Terrill screaming at [redacted] and VICTIM-1, he ran upstairs to the bathroom and grabbed [redacted] to get her out of harms way. [redacted] said that he observed Terrill then push VICTIM-1 to the floor. [redacted] mimicked the movement of Terrill, with both hands straight out in front of him, make a sweeping motion in a clockwise formation. [redacted] brought [redacted] to her room and had her lock the door, he then called the police. It should be noted that [redacted] was in fear for VICTIM-1's safety stating that Terrill "Is scary when he drinks".

Terrill Hart was arrested and charged with C.G.S. 53a-61(a)(1) Assault 3rd Degree and C.G.S. 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct. He was transported to Middletown Police Department where he was booked and processed. Terrill is being held at Middletown Police Department on a \$10,000.00 Surety Bond and is scheduled to appear at Middletown Superior Court on Monday, June 24, 2019 at approximately 0900 hours.

### REMARKS

On 6/22/2019 at approximately 0939 hours, I observed a female (later identified by her Connecticut driver's license as Lisa Williams) skateboarding southbound in the middle of DeKoven Drive, approaching the intersection of the Route 9 and Washington Street. The area is not well lit and she was creating a traffic hazard to oncoming vehicles and putting herself in danger.

I pulled alongside of Williams and asked her to not skateboard in the middle of the road and asked her to utilize the sidewalk. Williams replied "no". I repeated my request numerous times and explained the reason for my request. Williams repeatedly refused to comply with my request and told me to "go away". I activated my overhead lights, exited my cruiser, and told Williams to get on the sidewalk. Williams complied and walked with me to the sidewalk. I repeatedly asked her for her identification, to which she refused. I warned her she would be subject to arrest if she did not comply. Williams refused and she was placed in handcuffs. I found her drivers license in her backpack and ran her through dispatch. Williams was found to have a warrant out of GA14 stemming from an arrest in West Hartford.

Williams was transported to the Middletown Police Department, where she was fingerprinted, photographed and processed. She was held on a \$5000 surety bond for violation of CGS 53a-173 Failure to Appear 2nd. She is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 6/24/2019 at 0900 hours.

The warrant was canceled in the
