I advised other officers in the field that if they located Muff to stop him so that I can speak to him regarding the above case.

Officers located and stopped Muff who was walking in the area of Liberty Street and Pearl Street.

A check through Central Dispatch revealed that Muff had an outstanding warrant stemming from a previous case. Muff was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

Once back at Police HQ, Muff refused to be photographed and fingerprinted. He was consequently charged with CGS: 53a-32, Violation of Probation. He is being held on a \$10,000 dollar court set surety bond. Muff was placed in male holding cell #1 pending his arraignment at GA:09 on July 05, 2019 at 0900 hours.



REMARKS

On Thursday 07/04/2019 Detectives from the Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit prepared to execute a signed narcotics search and seizure warrant on 562 Main St. #6, Middletown, CT and the person of John Ingraham Jr.

This search warrant was obtained as a result of numerous complaints from local and neighboring residents, confidential informants, arrested individuals and anonymous callers from the area, as well as numerous hours of surveillance of the residence conducted by the Narcotics Unit in their ongoing investigation into illegal narcotic sales occurring in Middletown, CT. The Narcotics Unit has received reports from all of the above mentioned sources that John Ingraham Jr. has been utilizing 562 Main St. #6, Middletown, CT to sell Heroin/Fentanyl.

At approximately 0920 hours, Middletown Police Narcotics Detectives observed John Ingraham Jr. exit his residence while walking a small dog. Ingraham proceeded N/B to Los Primos bodega entered the store. Several minutes later, Ingraham exited the store and began walking S/B. Detectives made contact with Ingraham on Main St. at the intersections of Green St. Ingraham was detained in handcuffs and advised of the search warrant for both his person and residence. I verbally advised Ingraham Jr. of his Miranda rights on scene and he stated he understood his rights.

Ingraham stated he had "some shit" in his pants pocket. In his right pants pocket I located a black cylindrical film container which was found to contain (4) bags of suspected heroin/fentanyl.

In his right rear pocket I located a large amount of US currency, later determined to be \$191.00, and a black Motorola smart cell phone.

Ingraham was advised that he was under arrest and secured in a marked vehicle. Detectives then proceeded to the residence, 562 Main St. #6, with the small dog. Upon arrival, Detectives announced their presence and intent to serve a signed search and seizure warrant. After several seconds of no one answering the door, and feeling that those inside may either be hiding, attempting to destroy evidence, or attempting to retrieve weapons to use against police, they entered the unlocked apartment door.

Upon making entry into the apartment, two parties were located and detained. Both stated they were unaware of any drugs or contraband located in the residence. No contraband was located on either person.

Once the residence was secured, Detectives began a thorough search of the apartment. No additional contraband was located inside the residence.

During the investigation it was revealed that John Ingraham Jr. listed his home address 112 Bow Lane, Middletown, CT, however, Detectives conducting surveillance regularly observed Ingraham entering and exiting both front common door and rear door for the third floor apartment at 562 Main St.

While Detectives were conducting the search, Sgt Yepes asked one of the residents if she was aware of the situation. The female claimed she was unaware of Ingraham's narcotics activity and that she had agreed to let him stay as long as he was helping with the rent.

Due the fact no contraband was located in the residence, the two parties were released at the conclusion of the search. The female requested Detectives advise Ingraham that he was not welcome at her home and he should not return.

Off. Stroud conducted more thorough search of Ingraham Jr. upon his arrival at Middletown Police Booking area. In both socks, Off, Stroud located large amounts of US currency, later determined to be \$420.00.

The suspected heroin/fentanyl was later tested, at the Police Department, by Det. Lemieux. It tested positive for the presence of fentanyl using NARK 33.

The street value of the Heroin/Fentanyl found on Ingraham's person was determined to be \$40.00 if sold at \$10 per bag. Ingraham is currently unemployed.

All items listed were seized at the residence and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where they were tagged as evidence and secured in an evidence locker. Due to the fact Ingraham has no recent record of employment in the State of Connecticut, it was determined that his cellular phone was purchased with and/or used as a nexus to facilitate narcotics

sales. The cell phone was seized as evidence. Detectives will be applying for a search warrant for the phone.

The currency, \$611.00 USD, seized from Ingraham, was determined to be the proceeds from the sale of illegal narcotics and was seized for asset forfeiture.

A check of John Ingraham Jr. criminal history returned; previous convictions for Possession of Narcotics, Drug/Narcotic Equipment Possession (FL), Trespass (FL), Failure to Appear, 2 counts (FL).

It should be noted that the location Ingraham was detained and found in possession of narcotics is 1474' from the MacDonough Elementary School. See attached map of the area for additional information.

John Ingraham was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where he was read his rights, fingerprinted and processed for violations of;

CGS 21a-279(a)(1) - Possession of Narcotics

CGS 21a-279(d) - Possession Within 1500' of an Elementary School

CGS 21a-278(a) - Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell

CGS 21a-278(a)(b) - Possession of Narcotics Intent to Sell 1500' of an Elementary School

John Ingraham Jr. was held on a \$100,000.00 Surety bond and issued an appearance date at Middletown Superior Court on 07/05/2019 at 0900 hours.

The accused was charged with the offenses listed on the warrant: C.G.S. 14-236 Traveling Improper Lane, C.G.S. 14-215 Operating a Motor Vehicle While License is Suspended and C.G.S. 14-224 Evading Responsibility. He was then booked, photographed and fingerprinted on these charges. The accused was later released from Police custody after his bond was posted by bail bondsmen.

On 06/28/2019 at approximately 1441 hours, Officer Pellegrini and I, Detective DiMassa were dispatched to the front of Mezzo Grille, 106 Court Street, for a well being check. It was reported that a female was asleep for a while inside of her black Kia Soul.

When I arrived, I observed a 2019 black Kia Soul bearing Ct. registration number AS49885, running and legally parked in front of Mezzo Grille. When I approached this vehicle, I immediately observed on the passenger seat, in plain view, a small brown container on top of some clothes. Inside of this small brown container were three ripped pink baggies with trace amounts of a white powdery substance. There was also this same white powdery substance scattered in the small brown container. From my training and experience, these small pink baggies are used to package crack cocaine, and the trace amount of white powder appeared to be in rock form as it was not powder, leading me to believe that the substance was crack cocaine.

I then observed a white female slouched over the center console of the above vehicle, asleep. I then yelled to this female, and she woke up, startled. I then asked her for her identification, which she gave me and I identified the female as Carleen McGeachie.

I asked McGeachie what she was doing and she stated that she had a migraine and that she suffering from "spotty vision", so she pulled over to sleep it off. McGeachie stated that she had been sleeping since 1:00PM, which is when she left family court. I then asked her about the baggies and white powdery substance that was observed on her front passenger seat, within an arms reach of her when she was in the drivers seat. She stated that lent her vehicle to her friend which she knows to use crack cocaine. She stated that she believed that did crack cocaine inside of her vehicle, which she stated that she did not clean before coming to family court toady.

I then conducted a thorough search of the interior cabin of McGeachie's motor vehicle. On the front passenger side floor, I located two ripped white wax baggies, with no markings, and a small, cut white straw, which is commonly used to snort drugs. Inside of the white wax baggies was trace amounts of powdery white substance. I then looked inside of her purse and specifically her wallet, which I confirmed it was her wallet by asking her. Inside of her wallet, I located a green wax baggie commonly used to package heroin. Inside of this baggie was a pinkish white powdery substance. Also in her wallet was a small, cut blue straw. I then asked her about the baggies and straws, which she stated that they were not hers, but I told her that I located them inside of the purse that she stated was hers when I asked her.

I then placed McGeachie in custody for violation of C.G.S. 21a-276(a)- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. She was then transported to police headquarters for booking and processing.

While at police headquarters, Detective Schreiner and I tested that unknown white substance inside of the baggies and in the brown container. We utilized NARC test kit #33, which is testing for Fentanyl and Heroin. We carefully followed the directions, which yielded a red to purple color indicating that the white substance tested positive for heroin. I then used Sirchie NARC cocaine wipes and carefully followed the directions. The white rock like powdery substance found in the brown container turned blue indicating that the white powder also tested positive for cocaine.

McGeachie was then also charged with 21a-279(a)(1)-Possession of Narcotics. McGeachie was booked and processed under UAR#8876918 for the above two charges. She was issued a court date of 07/12/2019 at 0900 hours, at GA 9, Middletown. She signed and was later released on a \$1,000 Non Surety bond.

Officer Pellegrini, later spoke with the complainant, who is a City of Middletown parking Authority employee. This employee stated that she saw McGeachie in her vehicle, sleeping, at approximately 12:30PM. She stated that she called the police when she went back at approximately 14:40PM, and saw McGeachie still asleep in her vehicle. This employee told Officer Pellegrini that she became concerned for McGeachie's well being.

There is no further information. This case is closed by the arrest of Carleen McGeachie.
