The City of Middletown, CT is preparing to remediate the former Remington Rand facility located at 180 Johnson Street, Middletown.

The State Historic Preservation Office has reviewed the subject project and determined that the proposed work will constitute no adverse effect upon the state's cultural heritage conditional on the professional implementation of appropriate mitigative measures. These measures are summarized in a December 7, 2009 letter from David Bahlman, Division Director and Deputy State Historic Preservation Officer, to Brian Dillon, Program Manager, Department of Economic and Community Development, a copy of which is attached.

The specific measures to be addressed outlined in the December 7, 2009 letter are:

1. The full documentation of all structures (interior and exterior) to State Historic Preservation Office standards; and,
2. The preparation and submission of an article including a history and description of the Remington Rand industrial complex, photographs, site plans, and maps to the *Society for Industrial Archeology New England Chapters Newsletter*.

As such the City is requesting a fee proposal and schedules for performing this work.

Documentation for Items 1 and 2 above should be prepared in conformance with the standards established in the publication "Pathways to the Past" by the Connecticut Department of Transportation and the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism dated 2007 as outlined in the Chapter entitled DOCUMENTING THE PAST, Documentation Standards for Connecticut's Cultural Resources.
