The Finance Department has rejected that approach and has bounced it to this office. Therefore, the Redevelopment Agency should approve its payment from the \$5,000 appropriated in this year's budget for Agency activities. Payment of this bill will nearly wipe out the account.

Correspondence from Middlesex Memorial Hospital (MMH) - earlier this year when discussing the disposition of Parcel E-2, it was agreed that MMH would return to the Agency in September for a status report of their development plan.
