1. Gave an affirmative G.S. 8-24 Review for the extension of water mains to the area west of I-91. Applicant/agent City of Middletown Water and Sewer Department
2. Gave an affirmative G.S. 8-24 Review to install a booster pump on Bartholomew Road. Applicant/agent City of Middletown Water and Sewer Department

7. Granted Final Approval of a two (2) lot resubdivision of the property of GOFSCO, LLC located in the Home Depot Plaza on Washington Street. Applicant/agent GOFSCO, LLC/ Atty. Ralph Wilson S2009-1
