This notice shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the City of Middletown.

### REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about Monday September 13, 2004 the City of Middletown will submit a request to the HUD Hartford State Office for the release of Community Development Block grant funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake the following projects:

**Gilead Community Services Inc./ Roof Replacement**

Scope: Assist in replacement of a roof at a shelter.  
Estimated Cost: \$10,000  
Location: McKenna Drive

**Gilead Community Services Inc./ Fire Detection**

Scope: Installation of a fire detection system.  
Estimated Cost: \$5,000  
Location: 365 Main Street

**Russell Library/ Handicapped Accessibility**

Scope: Removal of barriers to those with disabilities.  
Estimated Cost: \$45,000  
Location: North End

**City of Middletown/ Main Street Streetlights**

Scope: Installation of streetlights on Main Street.  
Estimated Cost: \$75,000  
Location: North End

**City of Middletown / Down Payment Assistance Loans & Closing Cost Grants**

Scope: Encourage new homeownership for low/moderate income residents.  
Estimated Cost: \$80,000  
Location: North End

**City of Middletown / Residential Rehabilitation**

Scope: Assist in the rehabilitation of low/moderate income homes.  
Estimated Cost: \$40,000  
Location: North End

### PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Department of Planning, Conservation and Development. All comments received by September 10, 2004 will be considered by the City of Middletown prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

## RELEASE OF FUNDS

The City of Middletown certifies to the HUD Hartford State Office that Dominique S. Thornton, in her capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's Hartford State Office approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the City of Middletown to use Program funds.

## OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The HUD Hartford State Office will accept objections to its release of fund and the RE's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Middletown; (b) the RE has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the HUD Hartford State Office; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD Hartford State Office; One Corporate Center 19<sup>th</sup> Floor; Hartford, CT 06103.
