The meeting was called to order in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Building at 5:06 P.M. by W. Howard, Chairman.

W. McRae suggested that the person responsible for rehabilitation be called the Rehabilitation Evaluation Officer.

The possibility of using \$10,000.00 originally designated for recreational facilities in the first program year was suggested for the rehabilitation of 634 Main Street. Mayor Marino felt that the Redevelopment Agency staff should be responsible for the rehab program.

In discussing social service activities, the Council agreed that approximately \$25,000.00 could be made available. However, a public session should serve as a guide for the programming and distribution of social service monies.

F. Marino asked if the Housing Authority was eligible to receive any monies for structural rehabilitation to which the answer was yes. He further suggested that the Council visit the East Main Street area to familiarize themselves with the project.

The Council asked for a quick evaluation of the East Main Street new Post Office area for purposes of identifying potential street improvements.

The next meeting was scheduled for Monday, March 22nd, at 8:00 P.M. in the Council Chamber, Municipal Building.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:41 P.M.
