

Chairman J. Bianco called the meeting to order at 5:10 p.m. in Room B-20 of the Municipal Building. Using a list of 37 buildings eligible to receive a preservation award, the members present each designated their first five choices; and handed in their score sheets to be tallied.

W. Kuehn, Director of Municipal Development, handed out informational materials about the North End Housing Development Zone and Redevelopment Area; and asked the Board if they would serve in the capacity of a Design Review Board for improvements in the area. After discussion of the area, need for design review and functions of their Board, the Redevelopment Agency and the MDO, the Board agreed to serve in the capacity of a non-regulatory design review agency. Staff will send out materials pertinent to the topic.

The tally of preservation award votes indicated a tie for first place between the Middlesex Fruitery (specifically) and Middlesex Plaza (in general). It was the consensus of the Board to give both of them awards, since the ownership has always been separate despite their proximity.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:50 p.m.
