L. Wallace called the meeting to order at 5:00PM.

Upon a motion by J. Robinson, seconded by S. Englehardt, minutes of the February meeting were approved, as amended by A. Marino.

Next, L. Wallace opened a public hearing on the use of 2002 CDBG funds.

In the order reflected in the attached schedule, applicants appeared before the Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC) and presented their proposals and answered questions from the CAC. Among others, there were questions concerning the eligibility of the proposals for CHC, Red Cross, and Kidcity. The CAC directed staff to look into these questions further. Also, questions surfaced about the physical feasibility of the Middletown Youth Center's curb cut, and the ADA parking spaces on Main Street. These applicants responded that they would gather supporting material and provide it to the CAC (see enclosed). Middlesex Community College promised to forward material concerning questions about their foundation (enclosed).

The public hearing was then closed.
