Minutes

Upon a motion by W. Pillarella, seconded by C. Giuliano, the minutes of February 16, 1983 were unanimously approved.

Status Report

G. Mazzotta, Executive Director of GMCC, offered a status report of the Residential Rehabilitation and the Mixed Use programs. He reported that under the Mixed Use Program, several large projects were in the making and would commit the balance of the funds presently available to the program. A financial status report of the Rehab Programs was distributed. A revised copy is attached to these minutes.


Upon a motion by W. Pillarella, seconded by M. Maroni, an invoice in the amount of \$750 was approved for payment to GMCC under the contract for use of the Revolving Fund for residential rehabilitation projects.

Upon a motion by M. Maroni, seconded by C. Giuliano, the Committee unanimously voted to recommend to the Common Council that an additional \$47,500 be appropriated from interest on the lump sum draw to the Mixed Use Program.

Upon a motion by M. Maroni, seconded by C. Giuliano, the Committee unanimously voted that an additional \$60,000 be recommended for appropriation from the Revolving Fund to the Residential Rehabilitation Program.

In response to a question by M. Maroni, W. Kuehn advised the Committee that the engineering work for determining cost to cure estimates on 634 Main Street was approaching completion and that appraisals should be available by the May Citizens Advisory Committee meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 5:24 P.M.
