

COMMISSION ON THE CITY PLAN - EXECUTIVE SESSION - MAY 17, 1956

Chairman Traverse opened the meeting at 8:05 P.M.

Attorney John Pickett, representing I. R. Stich Associates, brought in a consulting engineer, Mr. Ralph Norman. Discussion on the pros and cons of installing sidewalks and the hardships this would involve ensued. After presenting their case, Mr. Pickett and Mr. Norman left. The commission upon further discussion, upon motion duly made and seconded, unanimously voted to grant the waiver of sidewalks on Bailey Road as presented by Mr. Pickett. The secretary was instructed to prepare a letter to Mr. Pickett and his client informing them of the Commission's decision.

After reviewing the petition of Attorney Vincent J. Scamporino for a change of zone on West Street and Washington Street, it was unanimously voted to hold a public hearing on June 7, 1956. The secretary was instructed to prepare a letter to Attorney Scamporino informing him of this fact.

The Commission voted to inform the Public Works Department that it has no objection to the Department's issuing of a building permit to William Anderson on the Ridgewood Subdivision. The secretary was instructed to prepare a letter to the Public Works Department informing it of this decision.

The reading of the proposed new subdivision regulations was tabled for a later date.

There being no other business on the agenda, the meeting was adjourned at 10:40 P.M.
