

THE COMMISSION ON THE CITY PLAN

The regular meeting of The City Planning Commission was held in the office of the Commission on June 22nd, 1944 at 7:30 P.M.

PRESENT: Chairman Russell, Commissioners Fisk, Goundry, Hippler, Hennessey and Warner., and His Honor Mayor Cubeta.

The Minutes of the May 16th meeting and Hearing on Zone changes were read and approved.

Report of Airport Sites for Middletown submitted to us by the Civil Aeronautics Commission and Mr. Keenan was read by Mr. Russell in which five sites were described with Number 5, located in Middlefield being recommended. It was recommended that a copy of this report be sent to Dr. Hill. It was voted that after careful study of this report with Dr. Hills committee to publicize this report. Miss Warner was asked to make a few copies and to write Mr. Ingalls regarding a more specific statement of the necessary size needed for an airfield, and to inquire as to who has already made application for Commercial Airline transportation.

Letter from Mr. Lawrence Moore was read relative to the rezoning work for the Commission. The motion was made to have Mr. Moore proceed with the first phase as outlined but prior to doing any work, meet with the Commission for a better understanding of our requirements and work to be done.

Oral and written reports on The Future Middletown were presented. Mayor Cubeta, Mr. Goundry and Mr. Hippler gave some very helpful suggestions ; Development of River-front, Airport, Better Hotel Facilities, Bus Terminal, Modern Municipal center, Consolidation of City and School systems, encourage more Industry , Up to date Zoning Laws, Better parks for recreation, more publicity for Middletown,.

No further business was brought up and the meeting adjourned at 10:15 P.M.
