

ADJOURNED MEETING OF CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

JULY 15, 1935.

Meeting held July 15, 1935. An adjourned meeting of the Commission on the City Plan was held in the City Chambers of the Municipal Building on Monday afternoon, July 15, 1935.

Present. Present: Commissioners Davis, Wadsworth and Murphy; His Honor Leo B. Santangelo, Mayor, Samuel C. Cannon, Superintendent of Public Works, and Corporation Counsel Don Cambria.

Absent. Absent: Commissioners Russell, Chairman; Thompson and Wilcox.

Acting Chairman. In the absence of Chairman Russell, Commissioner Davis acted as Chairman.

Acting Sec'y. In the absence of Secretary Wilcox, Commissioner Murphy acted as Secretary.

Meeting called to order. The meeting was called to order at 3 o'clock, P.M., EST.

Minutes of previous meeting approved after correction. The minutes of the meeting of July 8th were approved after being corrected as follows:
To change the word "thereof" to "project" in regard to Mr. Spencer's statement and to change the wording of the last clause in regard to reference to Corporation Counsel so that the clause would include the purposes for which the building would be used.

Oral Opinion of Corporation Counsel. In the opinion of the Corporation Counsel as explained in the meeting, and promised in writing, the application of Wesleyan University to remodel the building at the corner of Court and High Streets for the purpose designated in the application would not come within the jurisdiction of the Commissioners on the City Planning because there would be no violation of the City Ordinance in regard to zoning.

Vote re; Jurisdiction of Commission. It was voted that following an opinion of the Corporation Counsel, the Commissioners consider this matter beyond the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Vote re: Notification to Mrs. Fife. It was voted that the Secretary be instructed to communicate with Mrs. Fife and explain to her the reason for the action of the Commissioners.

Meeting adjourned. No further business coming before the meeting, it was voted to adjourn.
