HIGHVIEW ACRES INCORPORATED: A motion was made and seconded that since the Subdividers were very cooperative, that they acceded to requests of the Commissioners for all engineering and subdivision data, required for future processing, and since there were no objectors to this petition, that the preliminary plan be accepted and approved as submitted by the petitioners. This was unanimously voted upon and the secretary was instructed to proceed with the processing of the preliminary plans to the Departments of Public Works and Public Health.
