After discussion, the Commission unanimously authorized the Chairman to release the Monarch Builders & Developers Performance Bond when approval letters have been received from Mr. Cannon and Mr. O'Brien.

The Secretary is instructed to follow these reports through and obtain the approval or denial from the Public Works and Public Health.


The same being true, regarding the petition of "South Acres", no action was taken. The Secretary is instructed as above.
