George Dunn and the project architect presented the proposal for the expansion and renovation of Snow School. The programming is for approximately 550 students. Currently there are 375 students, 15 total classrooms, and 66,550 square feet. He is working to protect significant site characteristics, trees, etc. Comm. Ann Loffredo questioned the site size. Comm. Anthony Vasiliou questioned issues regarding traffic. The architect responded. Comm. Anthony Vasiliou questioned the Little League fields and plans for lighting. Principal Nocera commented. Safety concerns were discussed. Comm. Anthony Vasiliou asked if the playscapes will remain open to the public. Principal Nocera responded yes. Lengthy discussion ensued regarding site characteristics. Comm. Anthony Vasiliou commented on the need for public parking and the need to relocate staff parking. William Warner commented on the need to communicate with the Long Hill Estates Committee and the Urban Forestry Commission. Discussion ensued. Comm. Anthony Vasiliou read the resolution into the record. On motion and second by Comms. Anthony Vasiliou and Ann Loffredo the Commission gave an affirmative G.S. 8-24 Review for the renovation and expansion of Wilbert Snow School located on Wadsworth Street. Vote was unanimous.
