

COMMISSION ON THE CITY PLAN - EXECUTIVE SESSION - NOVEMBER 21, 1957

The meeting was called to order at 7:45 in the Planning & Redevelopment Office by Chairman Traverse. The full membership was present.

A motion to waive the reading of the November 7, 1957 public hearing was made and seconded; and unanimously passed.

The Cameron-Grand Union petition for a change of zone on Farm Hill Road was tabled pending further study.

The Plan Commission petition for change of zone in the Laurel Brook Area was discussed and passed unanimously. The change is to be made effective immediately. (Mr. Peters will prepare a statement of reasons for the action similar to those presented in his report to the Commission.)

The petition of Attorney Snow and Fontanella for changes of zone on Washington Street were studied and discussed. By unanimous vote, Chairman Traverse was authorized to contact the attorneys to determine what action they wish to be taken regarding hearing dates.

Mr. Peters was asked to make a study of Washington Street commercial usage and to make a report regarding needed zoning changes.

The matter of Rolling Green Park was discussed and tabled pending action by and receipt of required documents from its proponents (Attorney Edelberg is the counsel).

The matter of Lisa Lane was discussed and tabled pending action by and receipt of required documents from its proponents (Seb. J. Passanesi).

The Commission has taken under advisement a suggestion that a paid stenographer be engaged to record & transcribe public hearing minutes.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
