### PRESERVATION BOARD

1. Bylaws (The planning office staff will prepare a draft for the Boards further action. We will offer the very simplest format to articulate the Board's purpose, officers, meetings, order of business etc.) \*(Draft enclosed with this mail-out.)
2. (a) Overview of P & Z information and regulations related to preservation.  
(b) Review of Planning and Zoning Commission proposed updated goals and objectives as they relate to the Preservation Board's role.
3. Design watch concept. Proposal to request a review and comment opportunity of major development projects prior to approvals by City agencies.
4. Suggestion to Mayor to appoint a Preservation Board member to represent the Middlesex Historical Society.
5. Consideration for cooperating with the City's Russell Library to help preserve and display various historic artifacts that are not in the form of fixed buildings or structures.
6. Preservation project award concept. Recognition of City wide restoration projects that are in harmony with Middletown's historic preservation movement.
