RFP – Omo Manufacturing Site

The Department of Planning, Conservation and Development is requesting proposals to acquire the services of an Environmental Consulting Firm to conduct environmental oversight at the former Omo Manufacturing Site located at 50 Walnut Street in Middletown, CT. The following tasks shall be performed in accordance with all appropriate CT DEP and US EPA standards:

- Negotiate with EPA to achieve an Administrative Consent Order
- Prepare Health and Safety Plan (HASP)
- Prepare Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP)
- Prepare Site Assessment Plan (SAP)
- Perform Site Assessment
- Prepare assessment and contamination report and cleanup plan (SAR/CP)

The City of Middletown has been named as a Potentially Responsible Party (PRP) by the EPA. The site is considered a Superfund site under the Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) and all proposed environmental investigation and remediation activities shall comply with federally recognized response actions under CERCLA.
